The Division of Information Technology (DoIT) is CSU Long Beach's enterprise technology organization and is responsible for providing high-quality, reliable, and secure information and technology services that facilitate student success and enable faculty and staff to do the best they can do.

Continuing to expand on faith-based and City partnerships to donate used serviceable computers to community centers to bridge the digital divide. In addition to donating recycled computers to a local church, DoIT is working with a local charity organization (Human IT) recommended by the City of Long Beach's Technology and Innovation
Department to donate our recycled computing equipment to needy families in Long Beach—currently, 85 recycled desktop computers, 27 laptop computers, and 13 monitors to
