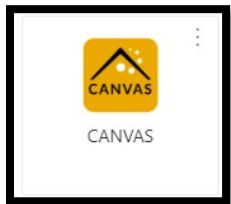

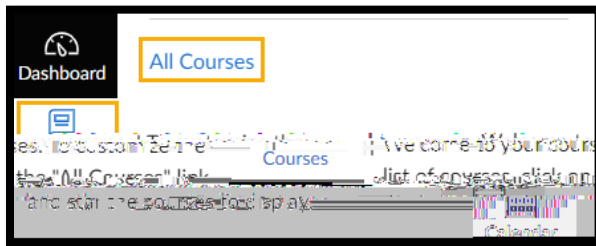

IDENTIFY YOUR MIGRATED COURSES

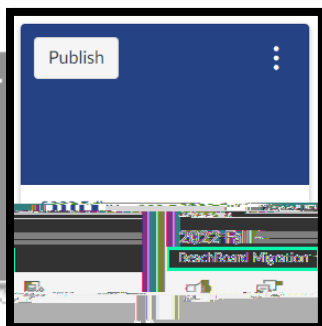
1. Log in to Canvas via the [CSULB Single Sign-on \(SSO\) portal](#).
2. Select the Canvas tile.



3. You will land on your Canvas Dashboard. You may need to scroll to see all your courses or click on **Courses** from the Global Navigation bar and select **All Courses**.



4. Locate your migrated BeachBoard courses. They are labeled in the course name with [0.6 (r6).03 0831 0 Td-(o)-3



IMPORT BEACHBOARD MIGRATED CONTENT INTO A LIVE CANVAS COURSE

1. From your [Canvas Dashboard](#), select and enter the **Live Course** in which you will be importing content. This is the course you will be teaching with, and it should be empty of content.
 - Each semester, live Canvas courses are automatically created for each section in the Schedule of Classes. Students enrolled in the class are added to "People" in Canvas.
2. Click on the **Import Existing Content** on the right-hand side of the course.

3. Next, select **Copy a Canvas Course** from the **Content Tools** menu.
