

Request for Modification of an Approved Project

Instructions: During the conduct of an approved project it may become necessary to modify or deviate from the approved protocol. Such changes must be communicated to the IACUC for approval prior to the implementation of the change by use of the Request for Modification of an Approved Protocol Using Animal Subjects (see form, below).

The form must be typed. Please answer each question using as much additional space as necessary.

Process:

- The Request for Modification of an Approved Protocol Using Animal Subjects must be typed and emailed to the Office of Research & Sponsored Programs (iacuc@csulb.edu) for Administrative Review and forwarding to the Attending Veterinarian.
- The Veterinarian will either forward the Request for Modification to the IACUC Chair with approval and comments or return it to the applicant for change.
- When the Chair and the Veterinarian both approve, the Chair will send the approved Modification to the Office of Research & Sponsored Programs indicating approval.

Notes:

- **Significant** modifications require full IACUC review and approval prior to implementation.
- Modification of radiation exposure, radioactive materials, carcinogens, or biohazards (including Recombinant DNA) requires new submission of the Radiation & Environmental Safety forms.
